TASTING NOTES

Vino z Czech Hrabal Frankovka 2012, (aka Blaufrankish, Lemberger) is a well known central European varietal and a favorite of the Czech people. This wine offers a lovely smell of clove and anise, and a rich, full body that is smooth and soft on the palate. 2012 is an excellent vintage with exceptionally well balanced tannin, producing a fine example of this variety.

VINIFICATION PROCESS

The wine spent 1 month as mash before pressing and then sat for 1 year in French oak barrels.

ABOUT WINEMAKER

Václav Hrabal established the winery in 1966. After a short break in production during the Velvet revolution, his 2 sons revived the family business and have built one of the most respected wineries in the country. The vineyards in Velké Bílovice possess a unique terroir, matched perfectly to the chosen vines. A balance of family traditions and modern technologies has enabled practices for the gentlest and most natural processing of the grapes. Continuing the tradition of sustainable wine making is not only their mission, but also a promise for a new generation of the Hrabal family.
