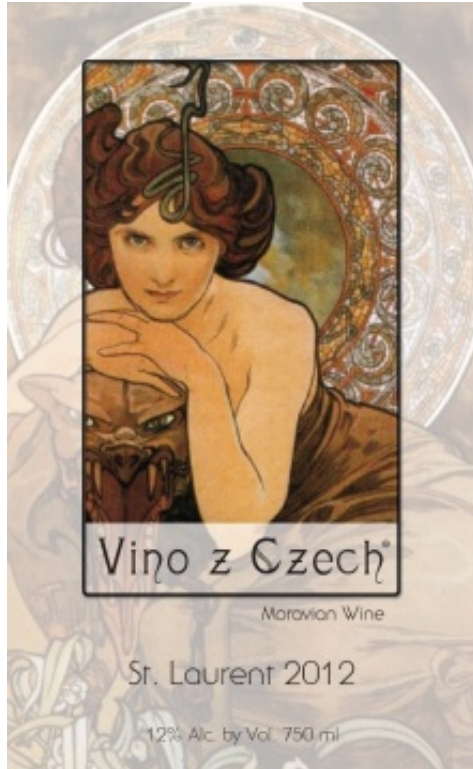

TASTING NOTES

St. Laurent (Svatovavřinecké) is a favorite of wine drinkers throughout central Europe. A close genetic cousin of Pinot Noir, these vines favor cooler climates, producing an earthy, full bodied wine with soft tannins. This 2012 from Znovín Znojmo delivers hints of root vegetables and fresh herbs.

VINIFICATION PROCESS

Fermentation was conducted at room temperature, in open barrels under method batonnage. The mash was then pressed, malolatic fermentation begun, and placed in stainless steel for 10 months before bottling.

ABOUT WINEMAKER

Znovín Znojmo Winery is one of the most widely recognized wineries in the Czech Republic and cellars wines grown in estate vineyards in a Medieval monastery. A medium-sized producer of premium quality wines, managing privately owned vineyards in and around the historic village of Znojmo. Znojmo was recognized with a VOC designation (like AOC in France, DOC in Italy, DAC in Austria or DO in Spain) when this system was introduced in the Czech Republic in 2009.
